Needs Your Help for Effective and Safe Snow Plowing!

PLEASE REMEMBER:

- **BETWEEN NOVEMBER 15 AND MARCH 15**
NO vehicles, trailers or any other obstructions are allowed on the road sides or dead end streets.
- **PLEASE DO NOT PUSH SNOW FROM DRIVEWAYS AND PARKING LOTS ONTO THE STREETS.**
If you must push snow keep it next to the curb or shoulder of the road to prevent a traffic hazard and to allow the plows to push it away.
- **PLEASE DO NOT PLACE THE SNOW**
Where the only choice for the city plow is to push it back into your driveway.
- **PLEASE PUT FLAGS**
By sprinkler heads close to the road to help the drivers see them through the snow.
- **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR MAIL BOX IS SECURE**
Wet, slushy snow being discharged by plows can break old posts, so please check your posts now, before the snow falls!
- **THE CITY IS NOT LIABLE FOR, AND WILL NO REPLACE**
Mail boxes that have been knocked down or broken due to the weight of snow or strong winds!
- **HOMEOWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE**
For shoveling the sidewalks in front of their homes. Please help our school children get to school safely by keeping your sidewalks clean.
- **WORKING TOGETHER IS THE ONLY WAY WE CAN HELP EACH OTHER.**
