

2019 West Haven City Municipal Elections

West Haven City will hold its municipal election this fall to elect one (3) three council members, all 4-year terms. The Primary Election date is Tuesday, August 13, 2019; the General Election date is Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

Any person seeking to become a candidate for a West Haven municipal office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person with the City Recorder *during office hours and not later than 6:00 p.m. between June 3 and June 7, 2019 at the West Haven City Hall, 4150 S. 3900 W, West Haven. (20A-9-203)

The qualifications to be a candidate are (10-3-301: 20A-9-203):

Be a United State Citizen

Be at least 18 years old

Be a resident of West Haven City or a resident of a recently annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.

Be a registered voter of West Haven City

Not be a convicted felon

Municipal Election Deadlines

June 3-7, filing period, Candidates must file with the City Recorder.

***Note: Regular office hours are Monday- Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

The City has opted to go with the vote by mail election; you will start receiving ballots in the mail 30 days prior to the election. You will still have the option of voting at City Hall on Election Day.
