## CERT

### Basic CERT Training September 14 - October 26

The CERT training class will be held once a week 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. in Ogden. To register, visit [www.webercountyutah.gov/sheriff/homeland/cert\\_reg.php](http://www.webercountyutah.gov/sheriff/homeland/cert_reg.php) or for more information, contact Lance Peterson at 801-778-6682 or [lpeterso@co.weber.ut.us](mailto:lpeterso@co.weber.ut.us). There is a \$30 participation fee for all new CERT participants. The fee covers the government required personal safety gear which is issued to each participant at the beginning of the class. West Haven City will reimburse all city residents that complete the CERT training.

### What is CERT?

CERT stands for "**Community Emergency Response Team**". CERT is a group of individuals who have taken the CERT training and have the basic skills needed to be better prepared in the case of an emergency. CERT training covers many topics including: Personal Disaster Preparedness, Fire Safety - Fire Extinguishers, Disaster Medical Operations (Triage, Medical Assessment, Treatment, Packaging and Transport) Light Urban Search and Rescue, Team Organization, Disaster Psychology, Terrorism Awareness, and Hazmat Awareness. The training takes about 20 hours to complete.

### Election Information

Primary Election – August 15<sup>th</sup>!

West Haven City is having a primary to decide who will appear on the official November Election ballot for City Council. The top four candidates who receive the most votes will face each other in the November Election.

It's always a good idea to check your registration at [www.vote.utah.gov](http://www.vote.utah.gov). While you are there, you can find out information about the candidates on your ballot.

Look for your ballot to arrive in your mailbox in late July. Eight Voting Assistance Centers will be open throughout Weber County on Election Day if you need assistance casting your ballot. Please visit [www.weberelections.com](http://www.weberelections.com) for a complete list of locations and secure ballot drop boxes.

In November, West Haven voters will choose a Mayor and two City Council Members.
