Some roads in West Haven are city roads and others are state roads. While road projects and maintenance affect our residents the same no matter who owns the road, we thought we'd designate which are which. Midland Drive, 1900 West, and 4000 South are all state roads. 2100 South is a state road from 1900 West to the eastern border of West Haven and 4700 West is a state road from 4000 South to the northern edge of the City. All other roads in West Haven are owned and maintained by our city employees.
