THE CITY WAS HONORED, THURSDAY, MARCH 16, 2006, WHEN GOVERNOR JOHN HUNTSMAN VISITED WEST HAVEN CITY HALL TO SIGN CERTAIN BILLS INTO LAW.

The Governor took time with each adult and child attending.



Governor Huntsman signed two bills into law and a Resolution. He invited young adults in attendance to sign their name as a witness to his signature. He then took time to explain, to each one, the bill they were signing ← and its meaning.

The bills the Governor signed into law was: A bill requiring parental consent before a minor receives an abortion; A bill mandating harsher penalties for sex offenders and a Resolution to support white crosses as memorials for fallen Utah Highway Patrol Officers.
