Mayoral Message

A Call to Action for Residents of the City

I recently met with representatives from UDOT and their consulting firm about the proposed alignment for the legacy highway through Weber County. They have reduced their proposed routes from 46 to 14 to 4 and now it appears to 3. Two of these routes I can't live with and need your help to lay them to rest. One of the routes is a 4-5 lane (between 110-250 foot right of way) highway replacing 4700 West in our city and the other one is worse. It would go diagonally through our city from the southwest corner to 21st Street and 1900 west. I'm not excited about a 4-5 lane highway dissecting our city. I have the political powers on my side, I have reason on my side, and now I need you to express your opinion on this to or at the following:

- at a gathering on February 10th anytime from 4:30pm to 8:00pm at West Haven Elementary which is located at 4385 S 3900 W. Originally this was to be in Roy, but I got it changed to make it easier for you to attend and I hope you do.
- send emails to westdavis@utah.gov AND chulet@langdonggroupinc.com AND bwuthrich@wfr.org AND sjenkins@utahsenate.org AND brad@zevlag.com AND rjefferies@utah.gov. Please do this so we can thwart this poorly conceived plan, and we will.

The other proposed route enters Weber County at 5100 West in Hooper and would continue along that path until 12th Street. That is the only one that makes sense. It causes some pain, but the others cause a lot more. PLEASE keep in mind this highway may or may not be built and is forecast for the future. How far into the future is anybody's guess.

Additional Pathways

We have submitted a RAMP tax proposal to the county for lengthening our pathway from I-15 to west of 1900 west along the Weber River. We have acquired the right from property owners to do this and are hopeful for a positive result on our request. We should know in a couple of months and I hope to be happy to announce the results. I'm very optimistic because we have done our homework and have submitted a very good proposal with a lot of support from other mayors and organizations.

Annual Audit

We have had our annual audits and the results have been presented to the city council. We are in good shape and I am thankful to present and past city officials for their watchful eye. A city property tax is not a thought with the council. West Haven remains a great place to live.

Cemetery

I have been spending a lot of time trying to put something together and remain focused on this project. If anyone has an idea, I'm open to hear it. We need 8 or more acres so if you can be of help, please contact Shanda at the city office and she can forward the information to me. The property doesn't need to be in West Haven City, but shouldn't be far from our borders either.
