Mayoral Message

The Weber and Ogden Rivers

We are in a challenging situation with the snowpack and weather patterns that we have experienced lately. During the night of April 18th, the Weber River overflowed its banks and caused serious flooding in our city. Tuesday morning several companies came to our rescue and I wish to express our thanks to them for their timely actions. Staker/Parson, Granite, Geneva, Triple H, Pappas Brick and Stone, and Martini Trucking came like a cavalry charge to our city's rescue with bulldozers, front end loaders, trucks, backhoes, and plenty of fill to build a road 650 feet in length, 20 feet in width and about 7 feet high to protect us from the Weber. They began around 9am and finished around 6pm and our gratitude exceeds our ability to express it. The city needed you and you stepped up relieving us of a monumental problem. THANK YOU just doesn't seem like enough.

The Cemetery

The City Council voted 5-0 to authorize the Mayor to close on the purchase of 10 acres of ground for a West Haven City Cemetery. The ground is located on the north end of 2350 West as it extends north off of 1800 South. The Council will be the governing body for development decisions and has voted to establish an advisory council for input. As it is

now public record, the city paid \$14,000 per acre to acquire the property. As funds are available, the future cemetery site will be developed.

The City's 20th Year Anniversary Dinner

Details of a celebration dinner to honor our 20 years as a city are being announced elsewhere in this newsletter. It is our intent to provide a prime rib dinner for those who pick up tickets for the event to be held on June 23rd at the main city park on 3300 South.
