Cemetery News

The City Council confirmed my recommendation for Brock Randall to be named the sexton of the West Haven City Cemetery. Brock has been busy attending conferences and talking with other sexton to learn more about his new position. He remains our recreation director as well. Staff is working on finalizing plans for secondary water to serve our cemetery.

Law Enforcement

The Sheriff's department will continue to provide service to our city as currently provided. A front page article in the Standard Examiner quoted another Mayor saying that he and his city were in talks with us about doing something together. That was news to me and I will leave it at that! It is accurate that the

Sheriff's department wants a substantial increase effective July 1, 2013. That remains an unresolved matter. They request an answer from us by the end of August. Time is ticking.

The newspaper article mentioned the county was going to reduce our property taxes about \$24 on a \$200,000 home. However, the county wants to increase our city's law enforcement payment \$550,000 which means about \$50 per resident. How is that to be collected? That is the question. As I mentioned last month, I am wrestling with potential solutions along with the city council. I will share information with you as we move forward.

Great Utah Shake Out

At 10:15 a.m. on April 17, 2012, Utah will hold the largest earthquake drill in our state's history. Citizens are asked to stop what they're doing and **DROP** to the ground (before the earthquake drops you!), take **COVER** by getting under a sturdy desk or table, and **HOLD ON** for one minute for the mock earthquake. After the minute drill, review your emergency plan and emergency kits. Conduct a home hazard hunt. Prepare your home by securing heavy objects (water heater, furniture, TVs). West Haven Disaster Response

In the event of a real citywide emergency (such as an earthquake), the 911 emergency number may not be available due to high call volume. In this situation, West Haven City is asking any resident with emergency needs to post a red item in a front window. If no emergency response is needed, post a green item. The item can be an article of clothing, a piece of paper, etc. Response teams will assess the neighborhoods and will look for obvious emergency needs and posted red or green items.

West Haven City Disaster Drill

West Haven City will be conducting a disaster drill **Saturday, April 14, 9 a.m. to noon**. You may see an increase number of people in the neighborhoods. We are asking any resident that would like to participate in this drill to post either a red or green item in a front window from 8:00 am to

noon to help our CERT and neighborhood teams learn to recognize posted items. Please note - no official emergency response will be made with regards to the posted items during the drill.

Community Preparedness Fair

Emergencies and disasters can strike at any time. It's important to take the time now to prepare for a disaster. The Community Preparedness Fair focuses on preparing individuals and families for potential emergencies. The fair will kick off with Utah's "Earthquake Lady" as the keynote speaker **Friday, April 20, 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm**. The keynote will be held at the LDS Chapel located at 4555 W 4000 S in West Haven. Preparedness classes will be taught **Saturday, April 21, 9:00 am to 4:00 pm**. Topics will include: cooking without power, sanitation, edible plants that can sustain life, alternative power, water purification, etc. There will be vendors selling supplies and the opportunity to make your own 72-hour kit. The classes will be held at the St. Mary Catholic Church, LDS Chapel, and West Haven City Center all located at the corner of 4000 S and 3900 W in West Haven.

CPR/First Aid Certification

A CPR/First Aid class will be taught **Saturday, April 28, 9 am to noon at the West Haven City Hall**. The class will cost \$10 per person for anyone who wants to certify or recertify. To register for the class, contact Stephanie Carlson at skcutah@msn.com.
