The sheriff and I came to a new number which he presented the next day to the Weber County commissioners and I invited him to attend our council meeting and present it to the city council. Get your HAM radio license

When a disaster hits and the use of traditional communication methods (cell phones/land lines) become limited or unusable, amateur radio operators (otherwise known as HAM radio operators) can communicate with others. To use a HAM radio, one needs to pass a test and obtain an amateur radio license.

The Ogden Amateur Radio Club is offering a class to help individuals learn the information needed to obtain an amateur radio license. The class will be taught 7 pm on all Wednesdays in January at the Weber County Sheriff Office - Training room - 721 West 12th Street, Ogden. The test will be February 6 at 5 pm.
