Elections

Congratulations to the candidates who will be on the ballot in November and thanks to all those who were part of the election process. It speaks well for West Haven that so many qualified candidates made themselves available for public office without great public clamor. Thank you for a good campaign and may it continue.

Walmart

Final approval was unanimously given by the planning commission and city council for Walmart to move forward with their development plans for West Haven. Both bodies were pleased with the submittals and Walmart intends to seek permits for construction in November with building to start in February. That is their current timetable.

Maverik

By the time you receive this newsletter, Maverik will have begun operations on 1900 West and 2550 South. We welcome them into the city and wish them much success.

Funded Road Projects

Although not totally approved, it appears highly likely that we have received approval for about 1 million dollars to improve the intersection where 3500 West meets Midland Drive. The state is now doing some engineering based on our recommendations to improve the situation that exists there. Additionally, we have received temporary approval for \$500,000 from the county to improve 2550 South east of 1900 West for about ¼ mile or more. Final approval is about a month away for these two projects. Also, engineering and the bid process is underway to improve the street situation near West Haven Elementary.

Cemetery

The Cemetery has been dedicated and is fully functional. I was informed by our sexton that we have already served the community. Many thanks, to those who helped with this project.
