West Haven City Emergency Communications Net

West Haven will be conducting an emergency communications net for West Haven on **March 8, 2014 at 9:00AM**. All Amateur Radio operators are welcome to join but it is specifically for Amateur Radio Operators that have been participating in ARES or are interested in supporting West Haven emergency communications. The primary Frequency will be 146.56 Simplex with a backup of the 448.60 repeater.

We encourage all West Haven Amateur Radio Operators to participate as a means of preparing for supporting the need for emergency communications in the city should there be a need in the future. The net will be simplex from the City Offices. Antennas on handhelds may work depending on your location but a mobile or external antenna will work better. We will be conducting these nets two times a year on the same weekend as much as possible. The next will be in early November. Citizens can be a big help in the winter months also by clearing snow and ice away from the grates until the city crews arrive to clear them. 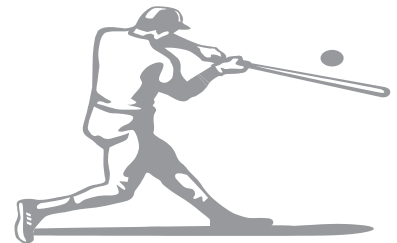
