### City Hall Seminar

### R.A.M.P.

RAMP was founded to help fund recreational, art, museum, and park projects in Weber County. Residents of Weber County approved this tax (which equates to about \$12/household per year) for a ten year period. The R.A.M.P. tax is up for renewal on November 4th. West Haven City has benefited greatly from R.A.M.P. funds. Reauthorization of the R.A.M.P. tax is vital to our city. Please spread the word about this important ballot item.

## Eagle Scout Projects

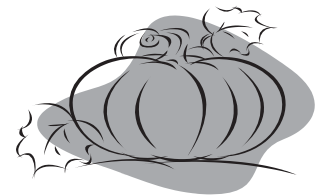
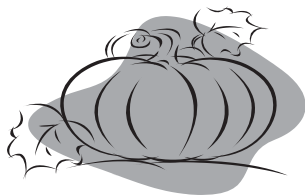
