## City Hall Seminar

The fourth in the series of FREE seminars will be on **Thursday**, **November 6th** at 6:00 P.M. at City Hall. **Chronic Pain 101** will be a presentation on chronic pain, its causes, and management. The seminar is for anyone coping with chronic pain. Those with friends or family members who have chronic pain are also welcome.

ParentsEmpowered.org is a great resource for prevention of underage drinking. The August seminar was an eye-opener:

Binge drinking begins as early as 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The brain peaks in development at birth, age 3, and in the mid-teens. Of kids who drink before the age of 15:

- 40% will be alcohol dependent.
- 67% will try other illicit drugs.

Three things will help prevent underage drinking:

- Bonding
- Boundaries
- Monitoring
