2015 ELECTION INFORMATION

West Haven City will hold its municipal election this fall to elect three (3) council members, all 4-year terms. The Primary Election date is Tuesday, August 11, 2015; the General Election date is Tuesday, November 3, 2015.

Any person seeking to become a candidate for a West Haven municipal office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person with the City Recorder *during office hours and not later than 6:00 p.m. between June 1 and June 8, 2015 at the West Haven City Hall, 4150 S. 3900 W, West Haven. (20A-9-203)

The qualifications to be a candidate are (10-3-301: 20A-9-203):

Be a United State Citizen

Be at least 18 years old

Be a resident of West Haven City or a resident of a recently annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.

Be a registered voter of West Haven City

Not be a convicted felon

Municipal Election Deadlines

June 1-8, filing period, Candidates must file with the City Recorder.

***Note: Regular office hours are Monday- Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

Where do I vote?

The City has opted to go with a vote by mail election; you will start receiving ballots in the mail 30 days prior to the election. You will still have the option of voting at City Hall on Election Day.

Pesticides, Herbicides & Fertilizers

Nationally, one quarter of the pollutants found in rivers and streams originate from the residential use of pesticides, herbicides, and fertilizers. These materials can enter into our waterways through illegal dumping, run-off from excessive lawn irrigation, and from heavy rains. The following guidelines if followed can greatly reduce the potential of these pollutants from entering our waterways.

- Use pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer only if there is an actual pest problem (not on a regular preventative schedule).
- Do not use pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer if rain is expected. Apply only when wind speeds are low (less than 5 mph).
- Do not mix or prepare pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer for application near storm drains.
- Prepare the minimum amount of pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer needed for the job and use the lowest rate that will effectively control the issues.
- Employ techniques to minimize off-target application (e.g. spray drift) of pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer, including consideration of alternative application techniques.
- Calibrate pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer application equipment to avoid excessive application.
- Sweep pavement and sidewalk if pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer is spilled or overspread on these surfaces.
- Purchase only the amount of pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer that you can reasonably use in a given time period (month or year depending on the product).
- Triple rinse containers, and use rinse water as product. Dispose of unused pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer as hazardous waste.

Dispose of empty pesticide/herbicide/fertilizer containers according to the instructions on the container label.

SR-37

IMPROVED

5100 West to SR-108

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) completed an environmental study and preliminary design of improvements to SR-37, from 5100 West to SR-108 (Midland Drive), in late 2014. In March of 2015, UDOT began the next step in the project - the design phase. This phase will include the final design of improvements and the acquisition of right-of-way. The design phase will be complete by the end of 2015 and construction is currently scheduled for fall of 2016.

The improvements, which increase safety and address future traffic needs, include:

5100 WEST TO 4700 WEST

- One travel lane in each direction with a center turn lane
- 4' Bike Lane
- 8' Shoulder
- Curb, gutter, park strip and sidewalk

4700 WEST TO SR-108

- Two travel lanes in each direction with a center turn lane
- 4' Bike Lane
- 8' Shoulder
- Curb, gutter, park strip and sidewalk

ADDITIONAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Drainage system
- Underpass with 10' wide trail at Hooper Slough

The project team will be holding a public open house to provide additional information on the improvements, the right-of-way acquisitions and the schedule.
