Utah Shakeout Earthquake Drill

The Great Utah Shake Out is an annual earthquake drill sponsored by Be Ready Utah and the Federal Emergency Management Agency. This year, the drill will be April 21.

All individuals are encouraged to:

DROP to the ground (before the earthquake drops you!),
Take **COVER** by getting under a sturdy desk or table, and
HOLD ON until the "shaking" stops (about 60 seconds)

All individuals are encouraged to:

Do a "hazard hunt" for potential items that might fall in your home or business during an earthquake and secure them
Create a disaster preparedness plan
Practice how to communicate with family, friends, and co-workers in the event phones are out of service.
Organize or refresh your emergency supply kits
Identify your building's weaknesses and make efforts to fix them
Enroll in a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)
