Thank you to Blaine Holmes who served faithfully for 16 years on the City Council.

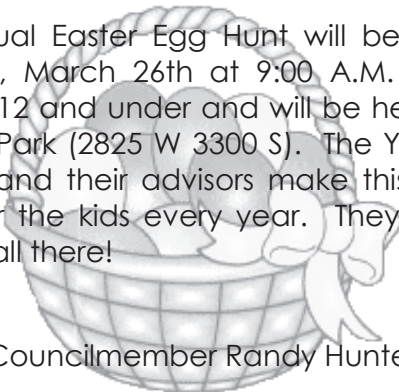
